



## Number of ESCMID members (male/ female) as per 15 March 2012





Candida spp. are the most common fungal pathogens responsible for invasive diseases in humans. Among them, Candida albicans is in general responsible for more than half of all Candida infections. However, recent studies showed a remarkable shift from C.albicans to non-albicans Candida species (NAC) at least in a number of centres. Candida krusei is known to be intrinsically resistant to fluconazole. Moreover, a decreased susceptibility to fluconazole among other NAC, especially for Candida glabrata has been reported. The changing epidemiology of candidemia and antifungal susceptibility data have an impact on the preferred empirical antifungal regimen. This study was undertaken to (i) state the ranking of Candida isolates among all positive blood cultures in our centre; ii) define the species distribution of Candida strains responsible for bloodstream infections and explore whether there is any potential increase in non-albicans Candida as compared to

C.albicans was always the dominant one [p-value for trend test between years 2001-2010 for C.albicans and non-albicans Candida species (NAC) was non-significant (p>0.05)]. There were 213 Candida strains with available AST results (123 C.albicans, 37 Candida parapsilosis, 27 Candida tropicalis, 12 C. glabrata, 5 C. krusei, 3 Candida kefyr, 3 Candida guilliermondii and one of each Candida dubliniensis, Candida lusitaniae, Candida rugosa). Among them, there were 188 isolates tested against fluconazole, 145 isolates tested against voriconazole, 151 isolates tested against itraconazole and 99 isolates tested against caspofungin. Available AST results interpreted according to the currently approved species-specific CLSI breakpoints are given in Table-2.






## Akademik Pozisyonlar, n = 650

# Kadın profesörlerin oranı (%)





## Guidance on How to Balance the Scientific Programme of ESCMID-Related Educational Events

Issued by the ESCMID Parity Commission

The Parity Commission has drawn up this guidance document in order to improve the balance of all ESCMID-related educational, professional and scientific activities in terms of gender and country of origin. The Commission believes that improved balance will significantly increase the level of quality of ESCMID activities.


We suggest as follows:

## 1. PROGRAMME/ORGANIZING COMMITTEES

Given the international nature of our Society, all ESCMID educational, professional and scientific meetings are by definition internationally oriented. This requires well-balanced gender and geographical distribution within the Programme/Organizing Committee. All efforts should be made to ensure a fair distribution of members within the Committee in terms of gender (neither gender should represent more than 70%) and by geographical region (see ESCMID definition of geographical regions: Attachment 1).



These grants are exclusively available for official Study Group research projects in the fields of clinical microbiology and infectious diseases.

## Funding

The maximum amount granted per project is EUR 30'000.

## Eligibility criteria

The research project may be based on laboratory investigations, clinical studies, experimental animal studies, or a combination of these. Research must be carried out in Europe and as a collaborative project involving at least two separate institutions in two different countries. Applications will be peer-reviewed and the best projects will be selected based on the application and research proposal (for details see next paragraph).

Applicants must be principal investigators for the proposed research. The Study Group(s) involved must display full support of this proposal by written approval by the Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer of the respective Study Group(s). The applicants must be ESCMID members in good standing. Members of the ESCMID Executive Committee are ineligible.

Proposals can be submitted and will be assessed throughout the year.

 PDF-Document (Surname\_StudyGroup.pdf max 4MB) with: summary of your research project (1 page); Introduction (objectives, background, rationale or purpose of the project); research plan (incl. design, material & methods, data

## The position of CMI - within international competition






# CMI: Submission ratio per population
